Principles of forming the Institute

The Institute will cater for the broad digital health community of health informaticians, clinicians, nurses and midwives, Fellows, executives, students, researchers, technologists, industry and organisations.

It will combine the functions of a professional college with a focus on the digital health ecosystem.

All existing functions of ACHI and HISA will be maintained

An individual's current status of membership will be reflected in any subsequent membership of the new organisation.





Principles of forming the Institute

The Institute will work collaboratively with Health Informatics New Zealand (HINZ) and not offer any services which compete with those offered by HINZ.
