

Call for Submissions Terms and Conditions

By submitting an abstract/paper you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- Submissions must be the original work of the submitting author(s), must not have been previously published and must not be under consideration by another publication or conference.
- All abstract/paper proposals must meet the format requirements specified by the Conference Organisers.
- The Conference Organisers reserves the right to refuse material that does not meet requirements or is deemed inappropriate in either content or size.
- Required documents must be submitted online. Abstracts, bio notes, portrait photos and papers will not be accepted in hard copy format or by fax.
- Abstract/paper acceptances will be advised by 9 May 2017 and final abstract/papers are due 22 May 2017.
- Details of the required format for Final abstracts/papers will be sent to presenters with notification of abstract/paper acceptance.
- Accepted authors must pay and register for the Conference by 22 May 2017. Failure to register will result in the abstract/paper being withdrawn.
- The Conference Organisers reserve the right to publish all submitted abstracts/papers via conference proceedings/conference app or other channels.
- For all accepted academic/scientific presentations (excludes posters), the abstract will appear in the HIC 2017 app and the paper will be published in the prestigious IOS Press series.
- You give HISA permission to publish a PDF of your slides on the HISA/HIC website. If you require modifications to your slides i.e. don't want particular slides published, it is your responsibility to email HISA and advise of the changes you would like to make.
- You give HISA permission to film or photograph your presentation at the Conference and make it available on the HISA/HIC website.
- If you are accepted for a presentation or poster your name, job title, organisation name, photo and biography will be included in the conference app.
- Submission of an abstract/paper will be regarded as acceptance of these conditions.
